Hazardous air pollutant records 6% drop for first time in 4 years

Linked To Move Towards Renewable Energy, Less Consumption Of Coal

New Delhi: India has recorded a 6% decline in emission of hazardous sulphur dioxide (SO₂) in 2019 compared to 2016 - the first decline in four years. But by contributing 21% of global anthropogenic emissions of sulphur dioxide, India continues to be at the top in the list of big emitters for the fifth year in a row.

The overall SO₂ emissions fell for all the top three big emitters - India, Russia and China - for only the second time on record. The declining trend continues, so far, even in 2020 thanks to a 10% drop in consumption of coal during the January-August period. Releasing these

findings on Thursday, the Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air (CREA) and Greenpeace India attributed the decline in India's SO₂ emission to the country's stride towards renewable energy and less consumption of coal. Their report on 'annual global

air pollutant that increases the risk of stroke, heart disease, lung cancer, and premature death, the Union Environment ministry had in December 2015 introduced SO₂ emission limits for coal-fired power stations and asked the power plants to install flue-gas desulfurization (FGD) to reduce the emissions within two years.

However, the deadline of December 2017 for the installation of FGD in power stations was shifted to 2022 after most of the units failed to install the technology within the given time frame. "The most efficient and easiest way to reduce PM_{2.5} levels is to install FGD and reduce SO₂ emissions from power plants as they form a

significant fraction of total PM_{2.5} pollution at different locations across India," said Sunil Dahiya, CREA's analyst and one of the authors of the report. He said, "Every single day delay in implementation of prescribed norms and not installing the FGD system is causing huge health and economic damage to our society. It's time the non-complying power plants are pulled up for inaction and damage to the society to ensure better implementation."
