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Results for the Quarter Ended December 31, 2002 under US GAAP WIPRO RECORDS 26% GROWTH IN REVENUE AND NET INCOME OF RS. 2.19 BILLION, 4% DECLINE

Bangalore, India and Mountain View, California – January 17, 2003-- Wipro Limited (NYSE:WIT) today announced financial results under US GAAP for its third fiscal quarter ended December 31, 2002.

Highlights:

- Net Income for the quarter was Rs. 2.19 billion (\$46 million), a decrease of 4% compared to the corresponding period last year. Revenue for the quarter was Rs. 10.87 billion (\$226 million), an increase of 26% over the same period last year.
- Net Income¹ for the nine month period ended December 31, 2002 was Rs. 6.4 billion (\$134 million), an increase of 2% over the same period last year. Revenue for the same nine month period was Rs. 30.6 billion (\$637 million), an increase of 25% over the same period last year.
- ➤ Global IT Services Revenue for the quarter increased 23%, at Rs. 7.4 billion (\$154 million), over the same period last year.
- ➤ Global IT Services Earnings Before Interest and Tax (EBIT) for the quarter grew 3% over the same period last year.
- ➤ 63% of Global IT Service Revenue for the quarter came from North America, 31% from Europe and 6% from Japan.
- ➤ 24 new customers added in Global IT Services during the quarter, including five that are on the Fortune 1000 list.
- Rs. 2.7 billion (\$56 million) cash generated from continuing operations for the quarter and Rs. 6.4 billion (\$134 million) for the nine-month ended December 31, 2002.
- ➤ Wipro Spectramind, our IT Enabled Services business, recorded Revenue of Rs. 540 million (\$11.3 million) and EBIT of Rs. 100 million (\$2 million) for the guarter ended December 31, 2002.

Acquisitions:

- ➤ Completed the acquisition of the remaining outstanding shares of Wipro Spectramind Services Ltd.
- ➤ Closed the acquisition of the Global Energy practice of AMS, Inc. The financial results from this practice will be consolidated beginning with our results for the quarter ending March 31, 2003.
- ➤ Entered into definitive agreements to purchase the assets related to the two Research & Development centers of Ericsson India Pvt Ltd at Bangalore and Hyderabad and the Research & Development center of EHPT India Pvt Ltd at Delhi. Employment offers made to 291 employees currently employed in these three centers. The transaction is expected to close in January, 2003. Concurrently, Ericsson AB has signed an agreement for purchase of consultancy services from Wipro for an amount of \$17 million up to calendar year 2004.
- Acquired a 40% equity share of Wipro Healthcare Information Technologies Ltd. (formerly GE Medical Systems Information Technologies Ltd.) held by Citadel Healthcare Ltd. for Rs. 97 million (\$2 million). Upon closing, Wipro Healthcare Information Technologies Ltd. will be a wholly-owned subsidiary.

¹ Excluding a loss (net of tax) of Rs. 404 million (\$8 million) pertaining to our discontinued ISP business which includes a loss from operations (net of tax) of Rs. 115 million (\$2 million) and a loss on write off of assets of Rs. 289 million (\$6 million) of the discontinued business. Net Income, net of the charge for the discontinued business, was Rs. 6.0 billion (\$125 million).

Outlook for the Quarter ending March 31, 2003:

Azim Premji, Chairman of Wipro commenting on the results for the quarter said "We see sustained volume growth with prices stabilizing in IT services and growing volumes and with intense price competition in the IT Enabled services. Our 10% sequential revenue growth in Global IT services business was the result of an 8% volume growth and a 2% increase in price realizations. In the IT Enabled services segment, intense price competition resulted in Revenues of \$11.6 million for the quarter ended December 31, 2002 against our estimate of approximately \$12.5 million. Enhanced operational efficiency contributed to a 10% increase in Operating Margin to Revenue of 18%, negating the 4% decline in price realization that we saw during the quarter in this segment.

For the quarter ended March 2003, we estimate the Revenue in our Global IT Services business to be approximately \$162 million, in Wipro Spectramind to be approximately \$12 million and in Wipro HealthScience at approximately \$2.5 million."

Vivek Paul, Vice Chairman and CEO of Wipro Technologies, our Global IT Services business said "Our Enterprise business which contributes 62% of our IT Services Revenue grew sequentially by 14%, reflecting the strong value proposition of domain based business solutions to our clients. Our Technology business grew 4% sequentially reflecting our technical depth and commitment to our Technology customers who continue to experience economic and business pressure.

In the environment of intense price pressure in IT enabled services space, our operational excellence and experience continues to provide us with a compelling competitive advantage."

Wipro Limited:

Total Revenues for the nine months ended December 31, 2002, were Rs. 30.6 billion (\$637 million), representing a 25% increase over the corresponding period in the last year. Income from continuing operations for the nine months ended December 31, 2002 was Rs. 6.4 billion (\$134 million), representing an increase of 2% over income from continuing operations for the same period last year. Earnings Per Share from continuing operations was Rs. 27.72 (\$0.58) for the nine months ended December 31, 2002, representing an increase of 2% over the Earnings Per Share of Rs. 27.13, for the corresponding period last year. Net Income for the nine months ended December 31, 2002, net of the charge related to the discontinuation of our ISP Access business unit was Rs. 6.0 billion (\$125 million).

Total Revenue for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, was Rs. 10.87 billion (\$226 million), representing a 26% increase over the corresponding period in the last year. Net Income at Rs. 2.19 billion (\$46 million), representing a 4% decline over Net Income for the same period last year. Earnings Per Share from continuing operations was Rs. 9.47 (\$0.20) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing a 5% decrease over the Earnings Per Share of Rs. 9.93 for the corresponding period last year.

Global IT Services (68% of Revenues and 89% of Operating Income for quarter ended December 31, 2002)

Wipro's Global IT Services business segment recorded Revenue of Rs. 7.4 billion (\$155 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing an increase of 23% over the same period last year. EBIT was Rs. 2.1 billion (\$44 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing an increase of 3% over EBIT for the corresponding period last year.

Operating Margin to Revenue for the quarter ended December 31, 2002 was 28.3%. This represents a decline of 6% from the quarter ended December 31, 2001 and a decline of 1% from the quarter ended September 30, 2002. For the quarter ended December 31, 2002, an increase in IT professional utilization of 6% was offset by a decrease in price realizations of 9.4% for Offshore projects and 7.7% for Onsite projects, as compared to the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Price realization was flat for Offshore projects and increased 2.5% for Onsite projects from the prior quarter. IT professional utilization declined 2% as compared to the quarter ended September 30, 2002.

For the quarter ended December 31, 2002, the R&D Services business unit, consisting of the Embedded Systems & Internet Access Devices practice (15% of Revenue), the Telecom & Internetworking practice (16% of Revenue) and the Telecom & Internet Service Providers practice (7% of Revenue), contributed 38% of Global IT Services Revenue, representing a decline of 13% from the corresponding period in the previous year. The Enterprise Solutions unit contributed 62% of Global IT Services Revenue. The Technology Infrastructure horizontal contributed 8% of Global IT Services Revenue across R&D and Enterprise solutions. The proportion of Global IT Services Revenues from North America increased from 51% for the quarter ended December 31, 2002. Accordingly, the proportion of Global IT Services Revenue from Europe declined to 31% from 42% for the corresponding periods. Japan contributed 6% for the quarter ended December 31, 2002.

Our largest customer, top 5 and top 10 customers accounted for 9%, 26% and 40%, respectively, of our Global IT Services Revenue for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, as compared to 15%, 34% and 46% of our Global IT Services Revenue for the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Twenty-four new clients were added in the quarter ended December 31, 2002, of which 5 customers are represented on the Fortune 1000 companies list. New customers added in current fiscal year contributed 11% of Revenue for the quarter ended December 31, 2002.

Customers with an annual Revenue run rate of \$1 million and above increased to 99 in the quarter ended December 31, 2002, up from 85 in the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Customers with an annual Revenue run rate of \$5 million and above increased to 27 in the quarter ended December 31, 2002, up from 21 in the quarter ended December 31, 2001.

Offshore Revenue for the quarter was 47% of services Revenue, up from 44% as for the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Fixed Price projects were at 36% of the Revenue for the quarter, up from 33% for the quarter ended December 2001.

We had 12,602 employees as of December 31, 2002, which represents an increase of 1,304 employees from September 30, 2002.

IT Enabled Services (5% of Revenue and 4% of Operating Income for quarter ended December 31, 2002)

Wipro's IT Enabled Services business segment (Wipro Spectramind) recorded Revenue of Rs. 556 million (\$11.6 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002. EBIT for the quarter ended December 31, 2002 was Rs. 100 million (\$2 million). EBIT includes acquisition related charges of Rs. 45 million (\$1 million) from the amortization of intangibles. EBIT margin for the quarter ended December 31, 2002 at 18%.

During the quarter, Wipro Spectramind signed Letter of Intent with 4 new customers. The number of active clients during the quarter was 9 as compared to 8 for the quarter ended September 30, 2002. Total employees in this business segment were 3884 as of December 31, 2002, representing an increase of 686 employees from September 30, 2002.

India and Asia Pac IT Services and Products (16% of Revenue and 2% of Operating Income for quarter ended December 31, 2002)

Wipro's India and Asia Pac Services and Products business segment (Wipro Infotech) recorded Revenue of Rs. 1.7 billion (\$35 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing an increase of 13% over the quarter ended December 31, 2001. EBIT for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, was Rs.56 million (\$1 million), representing a decrease of 50% over the quarter ended December 31, 2001. This was decrease was primarily attributable to a reduction in gross margin on traded products and an increase in Selling, General and Administrative expenses due to investments for market development in Asia Pac and for consulting business, compared to the quarter ended December 31, 2001.

Operating Margin for the quarter ended December 31, 2002 at 3%, represented a decline of 4% compared to the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Return on Capital Employed was 34% for the nine months ended December 31, 2002, compared to 52% for the nine months ended December 31, 2001.

Consumer Care & Lighting (7% of Revenue and 4% of Operating Income for quarter ended December 31, 2002)

Wipro's Consumer Care & Lighting business segment recorded Revenue of Rs. 740 million (\$15 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing a marginal increase over Revenue of Rs. 738 million for the quarter ended December 31, 2001. EBIT was Rs. 84 million (\$2 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002, representing a 16% decrease over EBIT of Rs. 100 million for the quarter ended December 31, 2001. Return on Capital Employed (ROCE) was 66% for the nine-months ended December 31, 2001.

Wipro Healthcare and Life Science (2% of Revenue and 0% of Operating Income for quarter ended December 31, 2002)

Wipro Healthcare and Life Science business segment (Wipro HealthScience), recorded Revenue of Rs. 250 million (\$5 million) for the quarter ended December 31, 2002. Loss before Interest and Tax for the same period was Rs. 12 million (\$0.3 million).

IT-related services provided accounted for 38% of Revenue, and Revenue from Wipro Healthcare Information Technologies Ltd. accounted for 10% of Revenue. Products and services sold in the Indian market through the Wipro Biomed division accounted for 52% of Revenue.
